French, Ezra

A lifelong resident of Attleborough, Bristol County, Massachusetts, Ezra French was born May 7, 1763, to Joseph French and Sibulah (Sibbel) Carpenter French. He was married to Jane Titus, and they had five children: Ezra, Fanny, Polly, Joseph, and Joab.

He served as a Private in the First Bristol Regiment of the Massachusetts Militia, a group of 130 able bodied men. This regiment was also known as Carpenter's Regiment after Colonel Thomas Carpenter III who commanded it from 1776 until 1780. Ezra French died March 13, 1806, in Attleborough, Bristol County, Massachusetts.
