William Teed, Jr.

Born April 5, 1750, in Albany, NY, he died after October 2, 1846, in Somers, Westchester County, NY. He married twice, first to Catherine Gregory and then to Ann Knox. He had eleven children with his first wife: Phoebe, Chloe, Margaret, Sarah (Sally), Isaac, Jane, Allen, William III, Lewis Almond, Susan, and Ann.

He served with his brother Charles in Colonel Pierre Van Cortland's Third Regiment, Westminster County Militia, and under Colonel Samuel Drake, probably fighting in the Battle at Long Island on August 27, 1776. He was granted a Land Bounty as a result.

William Teed, Jr. is buried in Mount Zion Cemetery in Somers, Westchester County, NY.
