

James Davenport

Jacobus “James” Davenport was born in August 1759 in Rochester, Ulster Co, New York. He married Maria Moule in 1786. They had seven children, at least two of them daughters, Catherine and Susan. He died on April 9, 1857, in Neversink, New York, at the impressive age of 98.

In the Revolutionary War, he served as a Private under Captain James De Witt, Josham Schoomaker, and John Hasbrouck. Then under John Hardenbergh and Colonels John Cantine and Wissenfels. He later collected a pension in 1838.

He died on April 9, 1857 in Grahamsville, Sullivan Co, New York. He is buried in the Davenport Cemetery, Neversink, Sullivan County, New York. He requested to be buried beside John Barnes and Peter Koons because they were fellow soldiers and had died previous to his death
