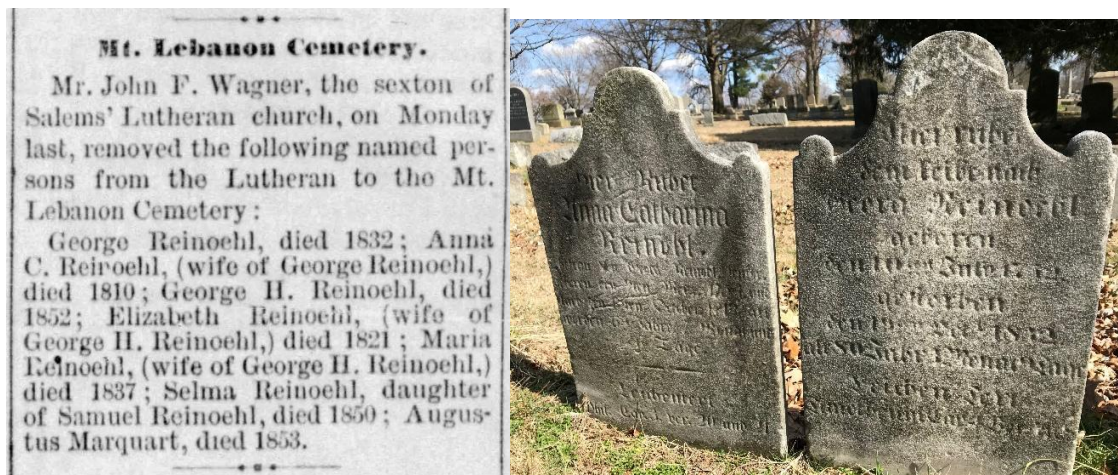


John George Reinhold

John George Reinhold was the son of [Georg Heinrich Reinoehl](#) and [Eva Katharina Reinoehl](#). Born on June 29, 1752 in New Holland, Lancaster, PA, his name was originally Johannes Georg Heinrich Reinoehl, but later was known by the English version of his name. He married Anna Catherine Ritte on 28 Jul 1779. They attended the Lutheran Church at Hill Evangelical Lutheran. John served as a Private 2nd Class in the 4th Company of the 2nd Battalion of the Pennsylvania Militia. He died on October 19, 1832 at the age of 80 in Lebanon, Lebanon, PA. He was buried in the [Emmanuel Union Cemetery](#) in Tusseyville, Centre County, Pennsylvania. As has happened to many ancestors, John George Reinhold's and Anna Catherine Ritter Reinhold's graves were later moved.

Mt. Lebanon Cemetery was first known as Union Cemetery Association with its charter dated March 30, 1859. The cemetery was later formed into Mt. Lebanon Association with the new charter dated March 11, 1870. This cemetery is approximately 100 acres. Over the years, several local cemeteries have had remains removed and re-interred in this cemetery, so burials prior to 1859 are possible. The largest group of re-interments occurred when graves at two cemeteries related to Salem Evangelical Lutheran Church in Lebanon, PA, were moved to Mount Lebanon Cemetery in November 1898. These cemeteries were located at 119 N. 8th Street as well as Second and Chestnut Streets. These re-interments were made in eight blocks in Section O, lots 139, 140, 169, 170, 183, 184, 213, and 214.
